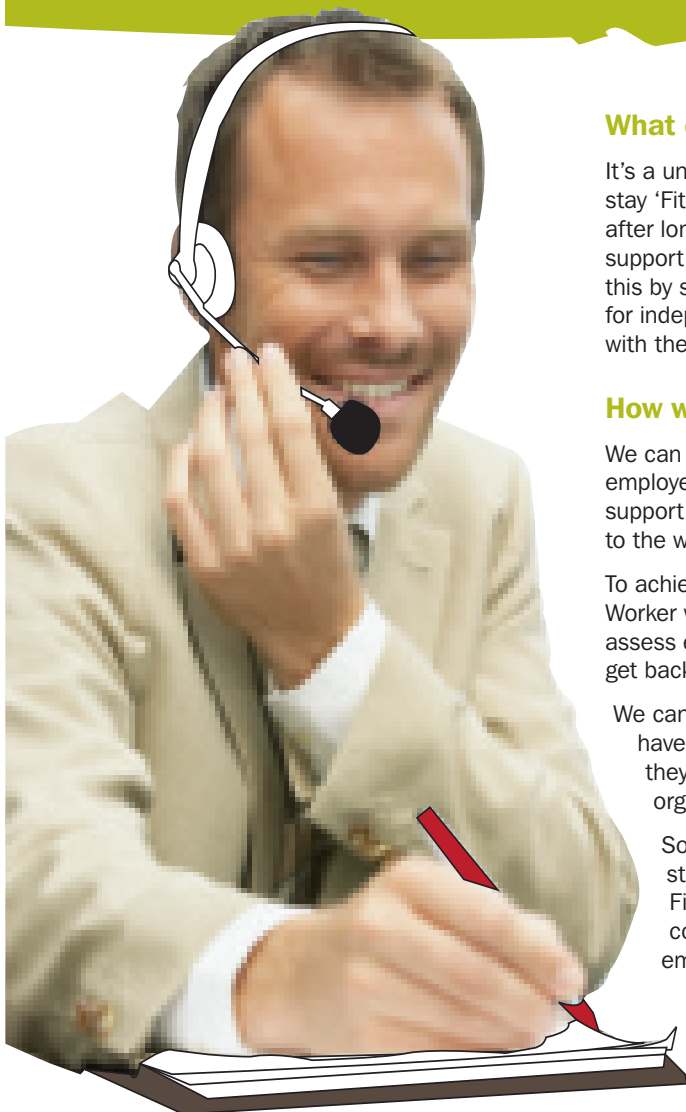

Do you currently have staff on long-term sick who you would like to see back in the workforce?

Absence from work is costing UK business £13.2 billion a year and 75% of the cost lies with staff who are on a long-term sick leave absence*. It's a great challenge assisting those with long-term illness return to work when they are fit to do so.

What does Fit for Work offer?

It's a unique service that aims to help people stay 'Fit for Work', either by helping them back after long-term sickness or indeed providing support to prevent them going off sick. We do this by signposting people in the right direction for independent advice and support for help with their condition.

How will it benefit my Company?

We can support you by ensuring that the employee who is off sick has received tailored support and is happy and confident to return to the workplace.

To achieve this, an individual Fit for Work Case Worker will be assigned to your employee to assess exactly what they need to help them get back to work more quickly.

We can also help you with employees who have received Fit Note to find out how they can continue to work within your organisation.

Sometimes relationships can become strained under these circumstances so Fit for Work can also act as a channel of communication between you and your employee.
